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PRIOR TO SURGERY

- **NO ANTI-INFLAMMATORY (NSAID)/BLOOD THINNER medications 2 weeks prior to surgery**
(Examples: Aspirin, Ibuprofen, Motrin, Advil, Aleve, Naprosyn, Vitamin E, or Fish Oil supplements)
- In general, ok to use Tylenol or pain meds prescribed by your surgeon the days leading up to your surgery.
- If on Coumadin (warfarin), Plavix, etc., you will need to discuss with your prescribing physician when to stop this medication. (Typically 5 days for Coumadin and 10 for Plavix)
- Diabetics – **DO NOT** take your diabetic medications on the morning of your surgery.
- **DO NOT EAT OR DRINK AFTER MIDNIGHT THE NIGHT BEFORE SURGERY (INCLUDING WATER)**
May take approved meds with sip of water if approved by physician

DAY OF SURGERY

- If you're having outpatient surgery, plan to have someone drive you to the surgery center/hospital and drive you home.
- Wear comfortable/loose clothing. If you're having shoulder surgery, wear a button up shirt.
- Bring your daily medications, insurance cards, and an ID.
- Leave valuables at home. Do not wear any make-up or jewelry.
- DO NOT SHAVE near surgical site as it can increase risk of infection.
- Bring an interpreter if you need some assistance.
- Surgery Centers will provide post-op instructions and issue medical equipment.
